

Yarn Thoughts Designs

Vieira Scarf

This yarn has a great luster and drape that really works with this textured stitch. The 20% wool content offers a touch of extra warmth, making it perfect for summer nights or an autumn/spring accessory. This pattern is simple enough for a beginner to follow, the main stitch is the US treble stitch, a long stitch that brings this scarf a lot of definition and texture.

Treble Stitch (tr): Yarn over twice, insert hook into the next titch, yarn over and pull through the stitch (4 loops on the hook). Yarn over and pull through 2 loops (3 loops on the hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on the hook), yarn over and draw through remaining loops leaving one loop on the hook and the stitch is complete.

Materials - Sirdar Bamboo Snuggly DK, 6 balls

Hook size - H

Chain 42

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook*skip ch 4, 9 tr in next ch, skip 4 ch, 1 sc, repeat from *, turn

Row 2: Ch 3, 1 tr in first sc, *ch 3, 1 sc in center tr of 9 tr (top of the shell), 2 tr ch in sc, repeat from * turn

Row 3 Slip sitich in space between 2 tr, 9 tr in sc at the top of the previous shell, 1 sc in space between 2 tr, repeat from *, slip stitch between last tr and the ch 3, turn

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until scarf measures 60 inches, ending with a row 3.
